Just some of the recent solutions Envirogen has delivered to its customers, include reducing wastewater discharge for Britvic Beckton. Using the latest 3D modelling, Envirogen developed a bespoke sterile



recapture system to store, clean and purify valuable high-quality rinse water and recycle it back into the process.

Another is saving water for Marston's. Originally commissioned to install a replacement softening vessel, after further investigation, Envirogen recommended and installed an upgrade, with a state of the art EcoSave water softener system delivering cost savings and increasing capacity. Finally there was Bevisols wastewater, which was reduced by 80%. The non-beverage manufacturer was exceeding its discharge allowance, resulting in costly tankering. Envirogen devised a water recycling solution that cut waste and incoming water bills.

The past few years especially has proved extremely successful for Envirogen, having experienced 30% year on year growth over the past 3 years. Strong growth plans were put in place which included the opening of new offices in Central Europe (Amsterdam) and the Middle East (Dubai and Bahrain). The Amsterdam office in Zaandam has been opened as a European Distribution Centre and has extended the company's capabilities into Central Europe.

CEO of European Operations, Vince Payne, adds: "As many of our larger, blue chip companies now have a presence abroad, these new offices allow us to support their wider needs and provide a fast and efficient service wherever they need it."
